



JASON AND JENNY'S WILD RIDE

Ready for any adventure: **Biggs** and **Mollen** tell *Us* about wreaking havoc in their new comedy, *Amateur Night*

"Working together could have been a disaster," says Biggs (in NYC April 13). "But it was incredible."



For Jason Biggs, wife of eight years Jenny Mollen is rarely just a call away. "She doesn't like to answer her phone. Ever," Biggs, 38, says. "It's disconcerting." Quips Mollen, 37, "He's superneedy!" But no one had to leave a message while they filmed *Amateur Night* (out August 5), in which Biggs' character chauffeurs prostitutes to gigs in order to provide for his pregnant wife (Mollen). The parents of son Sid, 2, share more with *Us*. **Q: How is this marriage different from your own?** **JM** I'd never let him embark on a caper without me. I'd

be like, "Hold on, motherf--ker. I'm Uber-ing to you." **JB** I wouldn't want to be in a caper without you. **JM** Because I would help you escape the cops!

Q: Is there a job you would never take?

JM I'd never work at McDonald's because of how they treat animals.

JB McDonald's sounds good right now. I'll tell you what I'd love to do: The NYPD has a dive division, searching for bodies and s--t.

Q: As parents, did you relate to your characters?

JB We literally just had Sid, so we tapped into the anxiety of having a new baby. **JM** I grapple with that feeling of, Will I ever be enough? I feel guilty when I'm working. I feel guilty when I'm not working.

JB He can see it now because he's too young to understand — or he's going to have to wait 15 years!
